

The North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (NC DHHS) had a Hispanic teenager in their care. She had run away from her home in Mexico and ended up alone in North Carolina in Guilford County. She was placed in foster care.

The department asked for assistance with its family finding efforts to locate the birth parents of the teen from a well-known non-profit agency, Children's Home Society of North Carolina. The agency, in turn, came to Forever Homes for Foster Kids for assistance since both parents lived in Mexico.

Forever Homes for Foster Kids took over the case shortly thereafter working directly with NC DHHS and successfully located and made contact with both biological parents even though they lived in completely different regions of Mexico. When notified, the child's father was very excited because he had not seen his daughter since she was two years old. This girl is now reunited with her father and in a safe loving home.
